Corinna Treitel studies the interplay of science, medicine, and popular culture in German history since 1750. She has published two books, one about occultism and the "disenchantment of the world" and the other about Germans' long quest to eat and farm naturally. *Gesundheit! Seeking German Health, 1750-2000* is the working title of her third book. Treitel co-founded her university's Medical Humanities program in 2015, led her university's bicentennial celebration of Frankenstein in 2018, and currently serves as department chair.
