The History Writing Center offers UCLA undergraduates **free**, one-on-one feedback and support on their writing. The HWC is staffed by tutors who are graduate students in the History department. HWC tutors are trained to provide one-on-one writing sessions for undergraduates working on papers for a history class or for history majors working on papers for capstone or honors courses. They work with students at ANY point of the writing process and tailor meetings to the concerns of each writer.

- Go to uwc.ucla.edu and click on the **Book It** icon to schedule an appointment
- Once you've scheduled your appointment, you will receive an email confirmation
- If you booked an in-person appointment, you will receive a text or email with information about sharing a link to your paper
- If you booked an online appointment, you will receive a text or email with the Zoom link and information about sharing a link to your paper
- For online appts., open the Zoom link on the date/time you booked the appt.
- For in-person appts., come to A61 Kaplan on the date/time you booked the appt.
